Suggested Itinerary



DAY 1

Arrive at Dubrovnik Airport. Meet & greet at the airport and transfer by coach to the hotel. Check in, dinner and overnight at the hotel.



DAY 2

After breakfast at the hotel, enjoy a guided city tour of magnificent Dubrovnik, followed by a lunch at the local restaurant. In the afternoon embark the boat in the old harbour to visit a small and precious island of Lokrum, just in front of the city. It is a nature and a special forest vegetation reserve, but also houses a small botanical garden with over 800 plant species from around the world, mostly from Australia.



Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 3

Following breakfast at the hotel, take a transfer to the harbour and embark the boat for a cruise along Dubrovnik Archipelago. The first stop is in the village Trsteno, known for its park architecture monument - Arboretum - dating back as to the 15th century when a local noble family started planting different kinds of plant species brought from abroad by naval captains. The complex represents the way of social life at the country in the Renaissance times.

The voyage continues to the island of Sipan to visit the Skocibuha, another country residence of the former Dubrovnik Republic. After the visit, return to the boat to enjoy a lunch.



The final leg of the voyage takes us to the Lopud island, the largest in the group. Visit Gjorgjic-Mayneri Park dating back from the 19th century, another example of country gentry life in the region. Enjoy a free time for exploring the island before returning to Dubrovnik.

Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Dubrovnik.

DAY 4

After breakfast at the hotel, depart by coach to the Konavle valley region, south of Dubrovnik, dotted by family farms and gardens growing vegetables, olive trees and vineyards. Arrive at the central village of Cilipi and tour the local museum of Konavle, an ethnographic collection of local arts and crafts. The tour proceeds to the Sokol Tower, a 15th century fortification used to protect the ancient Dubrovnik Republic from the east. Today, it is renovated and open for public.



A lunch of local delicacies will be served in the restaurant which has once been an old watermill. In the afternoon, visit the atelier of a local artist, an academic painter who produces various applied and decorative items created by several techniques like hand painted silk, pottery, and traditional Konavle embroidery. She has also revived the hand-made production of silk yarn used for embroidery applied on local national costumes and organizes presentations and classes of the whole process.



Before return to Dubrovnik, visit the lovely coastal town of Cavtat and its Bukovac Gallery – a famous Croatian painter. Walk to the Racic Mausoleum, a work of another famous Croat – a sculptor Ivan Mestrovic.

Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Dubrovnik.

DAY 5

Transfer from the hotel to Dubrovnik Airport for your flight home.
